



Immortal Stourhead 10k | Saturday 11th May 2019

Athlete Information

Location

Stourhead House is in Stourton village. There are very clear brown direction signs to Stourhead from the A303 near Mere from the south, and the B3092 from the north and then follow the B3092. Please avoid parking in Visitor Car Park. It is Pay and Display and only for visitors to Stourhead, not athletes, unless you are National Trust members.

Car Parking

Due to limitations with available Car Parking at Stourhead and it being Pay and Display, we have taken the measure of hiring the nearby Airfield so you can park for free. BA12 6QJ is the postcode and there will be clear signs to Athlete Parking. This should also be used by visiting spectators and family.

Registration

This is a short walk from the Airfield Car Park. You need to follow the signs to Visitor Centre. Pass through the Visitor Centre and follow the small black on yellow signs to Race HQ. These will take you to Race HQ in the Discovery Centre. Here you will be issued with your race number and a timing chip. Please ensure you wear your race number on the front of your running top. It needs to be clearly visible at all times. Registration will be open from 08:30hrs

Toilets

Stourhead has toilets near the Visitor Centre, and in the basement of the House. Additional temporary toilets will also be available. There are no showers available, but there will be a left luggage area if required at Race HQ. We cannot take responsibility for any left luggage, so avoid leaving valuables or car keys.

Race Start and Briefing

The start line for the race is a very short walk from Race HQ, at the archway at the foot of the drive to the House. The race will be timed gun to chip. It is important to assemble at the start relevant to your expected finish time. Quickest at the front, slowest at the back. A short race briefing will be given approximately 5 mins before the race starting at 10:00hrs.

Race Route

The Immortal Stourhead 10K is licensed by the ARC and has been permitted accordingly.

The route has been measured by GPS, and due to the high percentage of off road, will not be accurately measured. Indeed, the route may be subject to late change due to unforeseen bad weather, or tree felling.

The first 2k and the final 1k are on public highway. We will have measures in place to control traffic at the start of the race. On return to the highway in Stourton village the roads will be open so please exercise appropriate caution. **We will not allow the use of personal stereos at any part of the course. Users will be excluded from the results.**

Drink station

We will have a drink station at around the mid-point. This will have water in biodegradable cups. Please ensure empty cups end up in or near the waste bins provided. This is an area of outstanding natural beauty, and we must do our best to maintain it. **Any athlete seen deliberately littering will be excluded from the results.**

Awards

There will be trophies for top three male and top three female finishers. These will be presenting once the top three have finished, at the podium near the finish line outside Stourhead House.
