Athlete Information

We look forward to welcoming you to Stourhead. It is great to be back after a two-year enforced break due to the pandemic. The final preparations are well under way.

We need to make you aware of some important information prior to race day.

Location

Stourhead House is in the village of Stourton. There are very clear brown directional signs to Stourhead from the A303 near Mere from the south, and the B3092 from the north and then follow the B3092. Please note that the A303 will be closed between the Hazlegrove and Podimore roundabouts over the weekend of 13-16 May. During the closure clearly marked diversion routes will be in place via the A359 and A37. Please allow extra time for your journey if you plan on using this route.

Car Parking

Please avoid parking in Stourhead's main Visitor Car Park.

It is Pay and Display and only for visitors to Stourhead, not for athlete use.

Event Car Parking for athletes and spectators will be via Bells Lane, not the usual Stourhead entrance.

Registration

Registration will be open from 11:00 until 11:45

The bright orange registration tent will be at the main entrance to Stourhead, signposted from the car park.

Here you will be issued with your race number.

Race Numbers

Ensure you fill in the medical information on the reverse of your race number.

Your race number must be pinned to the FRONT of your running top, please bring your own safety pins.

Race numbers do not need to be returned at the end of the race.

Toilets

Stourhead has toilets near the Visitor Centre and in the basement of the House.


Race Start and Briefing

The start line is at the archway at the foot of the drive to the house.

A short race briefing will be given approximately 5 minutes before the race starting at 12:00hrs.

The route is in full view of the House, parents will be able to see their children at all times.

If a parent wishes to run with their child, we actively encourage this.
